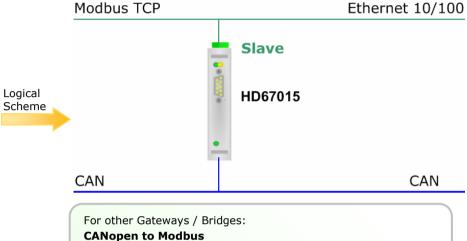

CHARACTERISTICS:

The CAN bus Modbus TCP Server Gateway allows the following characteristics:

- > two-directional information between networks CAN and Modbus;
- > electrical isolation between two Buses;
- > to read CAN frame from Modbus word;
- > to write CAN frame from Modbus word;
- > Temperature range -30°C to 70°C.

To configure the Gateway, use the available software that runs with Windows, called SW67015. It is downloadable on the site www.adfweb.com and its operation is described in this document.

The Gateway can be configured up to a maximum 250 CAN frame in reading and 250 CAN frame in writing.

CONNECTION SCHEME:

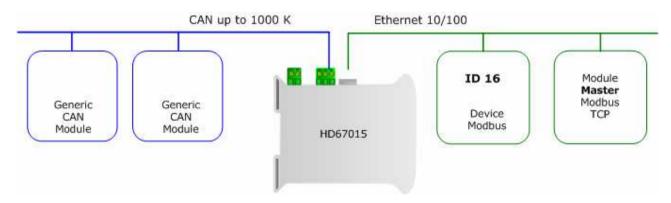


Figure 1: Connection scheme of HD67015 between a CAN bus and Modbus TCP

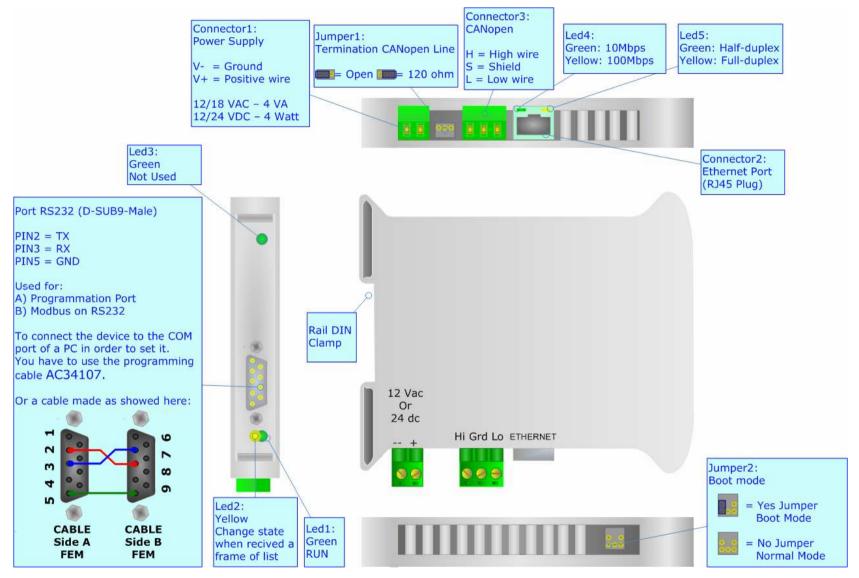


Figure 2: Connection scheme for HD67015

CONFIGURATION:

The "Gateway CANbus to Modbus" allows a CAN network to communicate with a Modbus network.

You need Compositor SW67015 software on your PC in order to perform the following:

- > Define that the CAN frame is reading from the Modbus;
- > Define that the CAN frame is writing from the Modbus.

USE OF COMPOSITOR SW67015:

When launching the SW67015 the following window appears

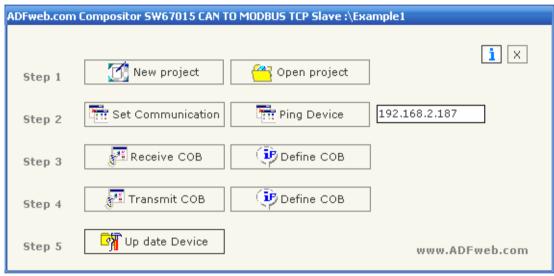


Figure 3: Main window for SW67015

NEW PROJECT / OPEN PROJECT:

The "New Project" button creates the folder which contains the entire device configuration. A device configuration can also be imported or exported:

- > To clone the configurations of a Programmable CAN to Modbus Gateway in order to configure another device in the same manner, it is necessary to maintain the folder and all its contents;
- > To clone a project in order to obtain a different version of the project, it is sufficient to duplicate the project folder with another name and open the new folder with the button "Open Project".

When a new project is created or an existent project is open, it will be possible to access the various configuration section of the software:

- > Set Communication
- Recive COB
 - Otherwise the **Define COB**
- > Transmit COB
 - Otherwise the **Define COB**

SET COMMUNICATION:

This section defines the fundamental communication parameters of two Buses, CAN Bus and Modbus.

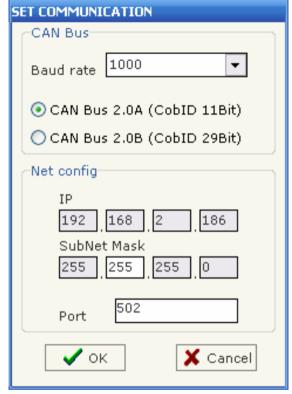


Figure 4: "Set communication" window

By pressing the "Set Communication" button from the main window for SW67015 (Fig.3) the window "Set communication" appears (Fig. 4):

- > In the field "Baud rate" the velocity of the CAN is defined;
- > Select the type of CAN (CAN Bus 2.0A CobID 11bit or CAN Bus 2.0B CobID 29bit);
- > In the field "IP" insert the IP address that you want to give to slave Modbus;
- ➤ In the field "SubNet Mask" insert the SubNet Mask;
- > In the field "Port" insert the number of port.

RECEIVE COB:

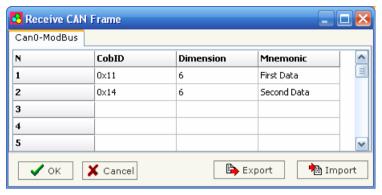


Figure 5: "Receive CAN Frame" window

By pressing the "Receive COB" button from the main window for SW67015 (Fig.3) the window "Receive CAN Frame" appears (Fig. 5).

A user who has to read a CANbus frame from CANbus to Modbus needs to insert the coordinates of the CANbus frame in order to be transmitted in the field "Receive COB" of the window.

- > In the field "CobID" insert the Cob ID of the CAN frame;
- > In the field "Dimension" insert the number of bytes of the CAN frame (the maximum dimension is 8 Bytes):
- > In the field "Mnemonic" you can insert a brief description.

DEFINE COB:

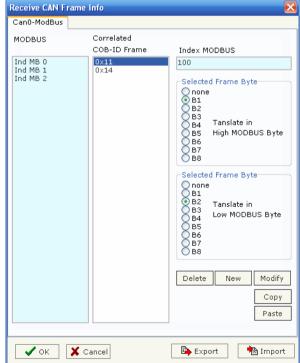


Figure 6: "Receive CAN Frame Info" window

By pressing the "Define COB" button from the main window for SW67015 (Fig.3) the window "Receive CAN Frame Info" appears (Fig. 6).

- In the field "COB-ID Frame" there are the COB-ID that you insert in the list;
- > In the field "MODBUS" there are the Modbus words (the maximum of words is 4;
- > In the field "Index MODBUS" there is the address that contain the Modbus word;
- > In the field "Selecet Frame Byte" you select the position of the byte.

For example:

Click on the "COB-ID Frame", insert the valid address in the field "Index MODBUS", select the byte position (B1 in "High MODBUS Byte" and B2 in "Low MODBUS Byte"), click the "New" button, then in the field "MODBUS" the names of Modbus words appear (The first word is name IND MB 0, the second IND MB 1, the third Ind MB 2, the fourth Ind MB 3).

TRANSMIT COB:

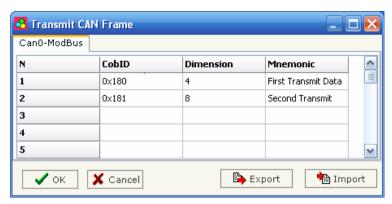


Figure 7: "Transmit CAN Frame" window

By pressing the "Transmit COB" button from the main window for SW67015 (Fig. 3) the window "Transmit CAN Frame" appears (Fig. 7).

A user who has to write a CANbus frame from Modbus to CANbus needs to insert the coordinates of the CANbus frame in order to be transmitted in the field "Trasmit COB" of the window.

- > In the field "CobID" insert the Cob ID of the CANbus frame
- > In the field "Dimension" insert the number of bytes of the CANbus frame (the maximum dimension is 8 Bytes);
- > In the field "Mnemonic" you can insert a brief description.

DEFINE COB:

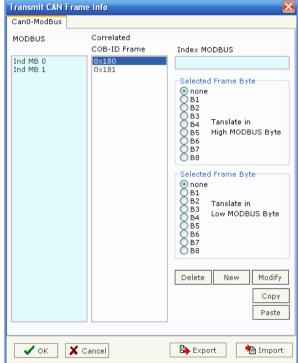


Figure 8: "Transmit CAN Frame Info" window

By pressing the "Define COB" button from the main window for SW67015 (Fig. 3) the window "Transmit CAN Frame Info" appears (Fig. 8).

- > In the field "COB-ID Frame" there are the COB-ID that you insert in the list;
- > In the field "MODBUS" there are the Modbus words (the maximum of words is 4);
- > In the field "Index MODBUS" there is the address that contain the Modbus word;
- > In the field "Selecet Frame Byte" you select the position of the byte.

For example:

Click on the "COB-ID Frame", insert the valid address in the field "Index MODBUS", select the byte position (B1 in "High MODBUS Byte" and B2 in "Low MODBUS Byte"), click the "New" button, then in the field "MODBUS" the names of Modbus words appear (The first word is name IND MB 0, the second IND MB 1, the third Ind MB 2, the fourth Ind MB 3).

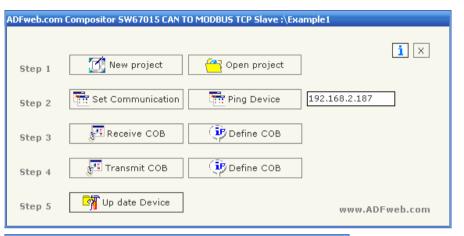

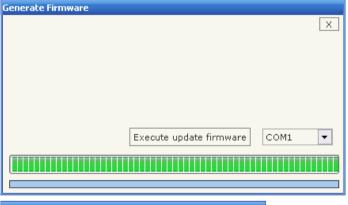
UPDATE DEVICE:

Section "Update Device":

Insert the boot jumper (see Figure 2).

In order to load the parameters after they are set, set the Com port you used for update, then you must click the button "Execute update firmware" in the principal window.





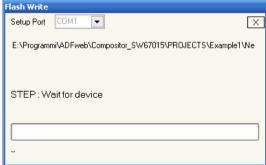


Figure 9: Update device procedure

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CABLES:

The connection from RS232 socket to a serial port (example one from a personal computer) must be made with a Null Modem cable (a serial cable where the pins 2 and 3 are crossed).

It is recommended that the RS232 Cable not exceed 15 meters.

The connection at Ethernet socket must be with a Ethernet Cable with a RJ45 Plug.

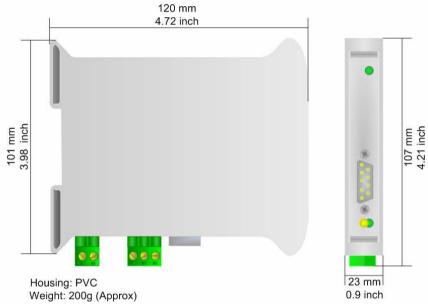


Figure 10: Mechanical dimensions scheme
