


Figure 1: Connection scheme for HD67136



#### **CONFIGURATION:**

You need Compositor SW67136 software on your PC in order to perform the following:

- > Define the parameter of CANopen line;
- Define the parameter of DeviceNet line;
- Define the data accessible from the DeviceNet that goes through the SDO of CANopen;
- > Define the data accessible from the DeviceNet that goes through the PDO of CANopen.

#### **USE OF COMPOSITOR SW67136:**

To configure the gateway use the available software that runs with Windows, called SW67136. It is downloadable on the site <a href="www.adfweb.com">www.adfweb.com</a> and its operation is described in this document.




Figure 2: Main window for SW67136

When launching the SW67136 the right window appears (Fig. 2).

## **NEW PROJECT / OPEN PROJECT:**

The "New Project" button creates the folder which contains the entire device configuration. A device configuration can also be imported or exported:

- > To clone the configurations of a Programmable CANopen to DeviceNet Gateway in order to configure another device in the same manner, it is necessary to maintain the folder and all its contents;
- > To clone a project in order to obtain a different version of the project, it is sufficient to duplicate the project folder with another name and open the new folder with the button "Open Project";

When a new project is created or an existent project is open, it will be possible to access the various configuration sections of the software:

- "Set Communication";
- "Set SDO Access";
- o "Set PDO Access".

#### **SET COMMUNICATION:**

This section defines the fundamental communication parameters of two Buses, CANopen and DeviceNet.




Figure 3: "Set Communication" window

By pressing the "Set Communication" button from the main window for SW67136 (Fig. 2) the "Set communication" window appears (Fig. 3).

This window is divided in two sections, one to configure the CANopen network and the other for the DeviceNet.

The means of the fields for "CANopen" are:

- > In the field "ID Dev." the address of the CANopen is defined;
- > In the field "Baud rate" the baudrate of the CANopen line is defined;
- > In the "Set Operational State at Start-Up" field you define the state of Operational at start-up;
- > In the "Network Start at Start Up" field you define a command of start (operational) to all the devices in the CANopen network;
- > In the "Delay" field the delay before sending the network command for the CANopen is defined.

The means of the fields for "DeviceNet" are:

- > In the field "ID Dev." the address of the DeviceNet is defined;
- > In the field "Baud rate" the baud rate of the DeviceNet line is defined.

"TimeOut SDO" is the is the maximum time that the device attends for the answer from the Slave interrogated.

#### **SET SDO ACCESS**




Figure 4: "Set SDO Access" window

By pressing the "Set SDO Access" button from the main window for SW67136 (Fig. 2) the "Set SDO Access" window appears (Fig. 4).

It is divided in two parts: the first is "DeviceNet IN" and the second is "DeviceNet OUT".

The means of the fields are the same for the two tables and they are the following:

- In the field "Index" insert the index of the SDO (coordinated with that SDO);
- In the field "Subindex" insert the subindex of the SDO (coordinated with the SDO);
- > In the field "nByte" insert the length of the SDO;
- > In the field "Mnemonic" you can insert a description.

## **SET PDO ACCESS:**




Figure 5: "Set PDO Access" window

By pressing the "Set PDO Access" button from the main window for SW67136 (Fig. 2) the "Set PDO Access" window appears (Fig. 5).

It is divided in two parts: the first is "DeviceNet OUT --> Transmit PDO" and the second is "DeviceNet OUT --> Receive PDO".

The means of the fields are the same for the two tables and they are the following:

- ➤ In the field "Cob-ID" insert the complete address of the CANopen PDO that has the datas;
- > In the field "Dimension" insert the length of PDO;
- In the field "Mnemonic" you can insert a description.

## **EDS FILE:**

By pressing the "GDS File" button is possible to save the GDS file for the CANopen side. With this feature you can save the configuration of the gateway of the CANopen side.


## **UPDATE DEVICE:**


Section "UP Date Device":

In order to load the parameters or update the firmware in the gateway, follow these instructions:

- > Turn OFF the device;
- > Connect the Null Modem Cable from your PC to the Gateway;
- > Insert the Boot Jumper (For more info see Fig. 1);
- > Turn ON the Device;
- Check the Boot Led. It must blink quickly (For more info see Fig. 1)
- Select the COM port and press the "Execute update firmware" button to start the upload;
- > When all the operation are "OK" turn OFF the Device;
- Disconnect the Boot Jumper;
- Disconnect the RS232 cable;
- Turn ON the device.

At this point the configuration/firmware on the Device is correctly updated.








Figure 6: "Update Device" windows

## **CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CABLES:**

The connection from RS232 socket to a serial port (example one from a personal computer) must be made with a NULL MODEM cable (a serial cable where the pins 2 and 3 are crossed).

It is recommended that the RS232C Cable not exceed 15 meters.




Figure 7: Null modem cabling




Figure 8: Mechanical dimensions scheme
